## STATISTICS 2009 CONTENTS

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"Statistics 2009" are the yearly statistics in English on the Cattle and Beef Sector. The "Statistics" is a collection of tables and figures on structure, cattle population, slaughtering, production, trade, prices, etc. for Denmark.

The establishing of the Single Market with effect from January 1, 1993, resulting in a changed collection of statistics, has caused that trade figures between the EU countries since then have not comprised all transactions.

Collection, collation and editing of data have been made by the Danish Agriculture & Food Council<sup>1</sup>, ECONOMIC ANALYSIS & STATISTICS on behalf of the Danish Livestock and Meat Board (DLMB). Both external and own data have been used which will appear from the source reference of the individual tables.

The production decreased slightly in 2009 and less than consumption for the second year in a row.

According to Statistics Denmark 25.5 kg per inhabitant were available for consumption in 2009. This is a decline of 0.9 kg or 3.4 % from 2008 in carcase weight equivalent. The actual consumption is markedly smaller. According to Gfk Consumer Scan direct household purchases of beef and veal as cuts and minced meat amounted to 6.7 kg/person in 2009. This is an increase of 0.2 kg from 2008.

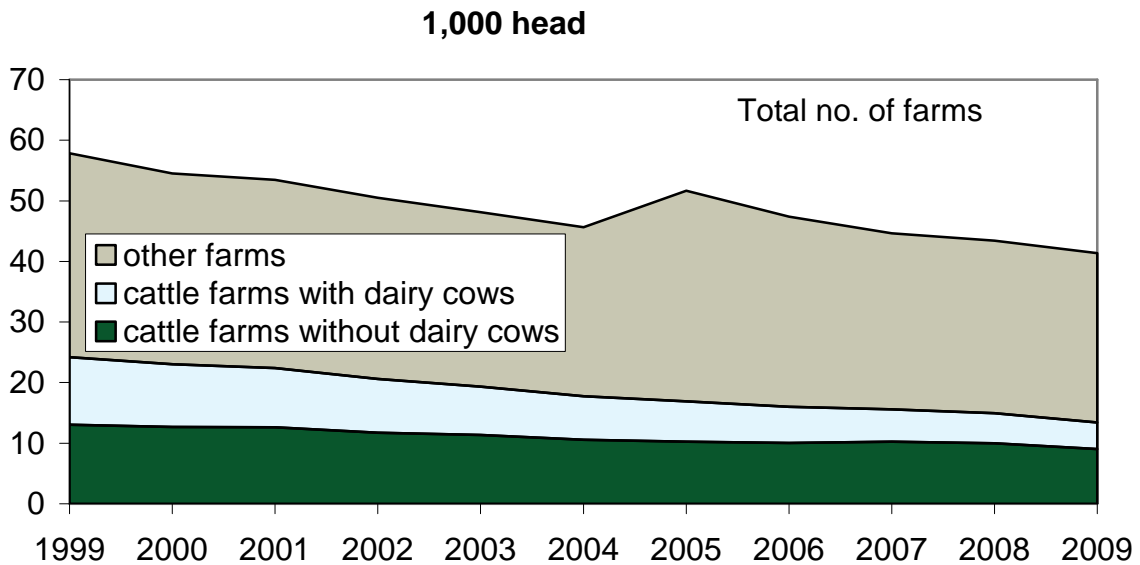

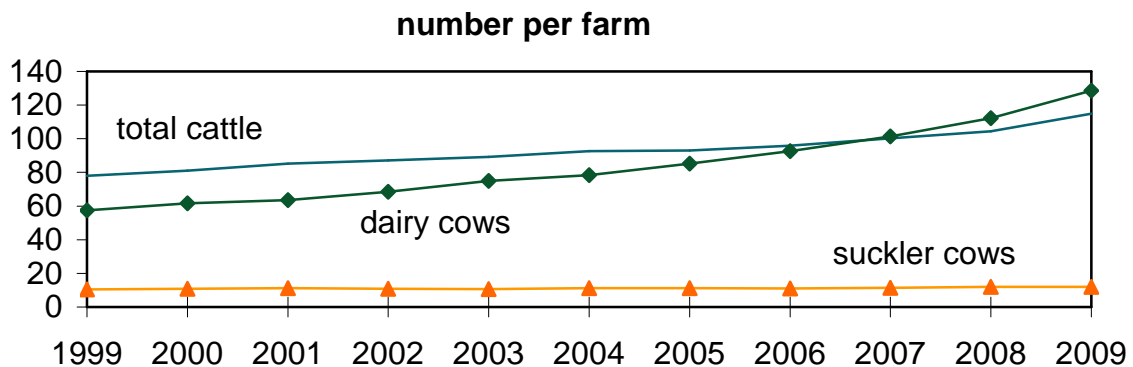

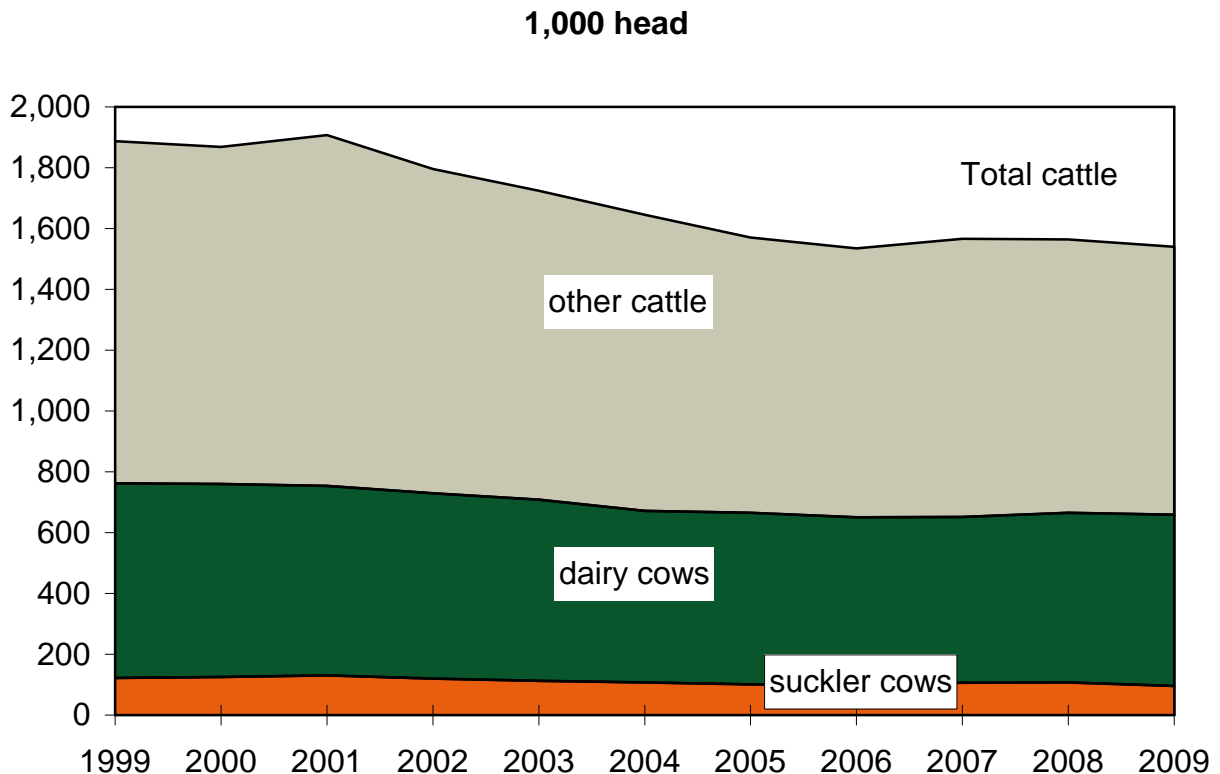

**Figure 3: POPULATION OF CATTLE AND COWS**



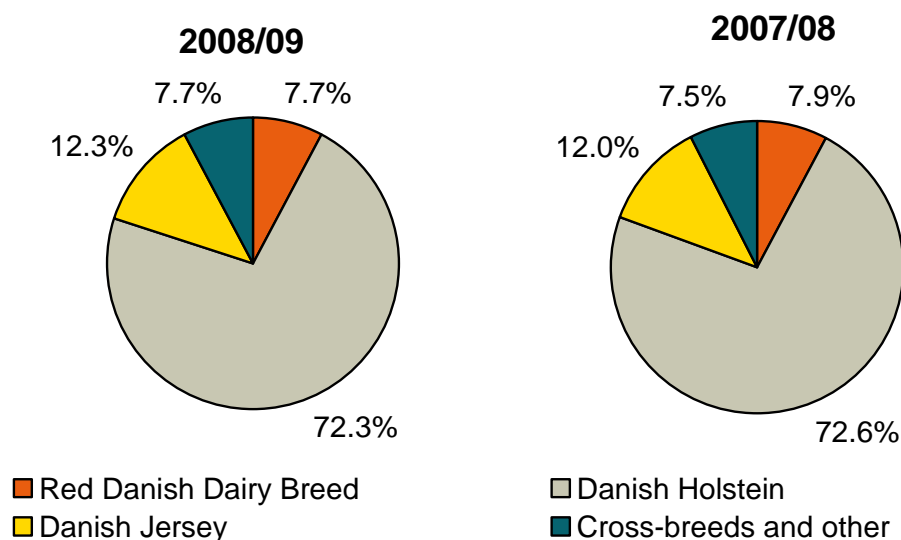

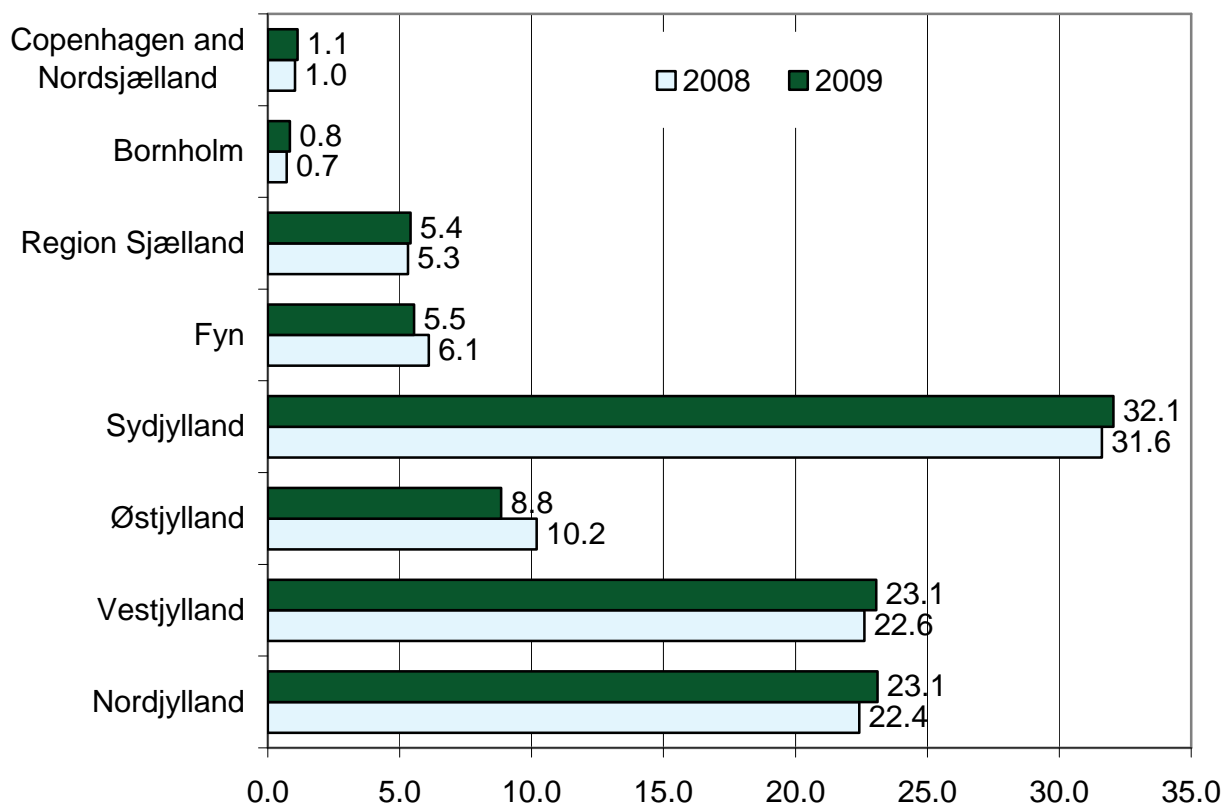
A surveillance programme for salmonella Dublin has been established where all herds are given a level on the basis of examinations for antisubstance or contact.

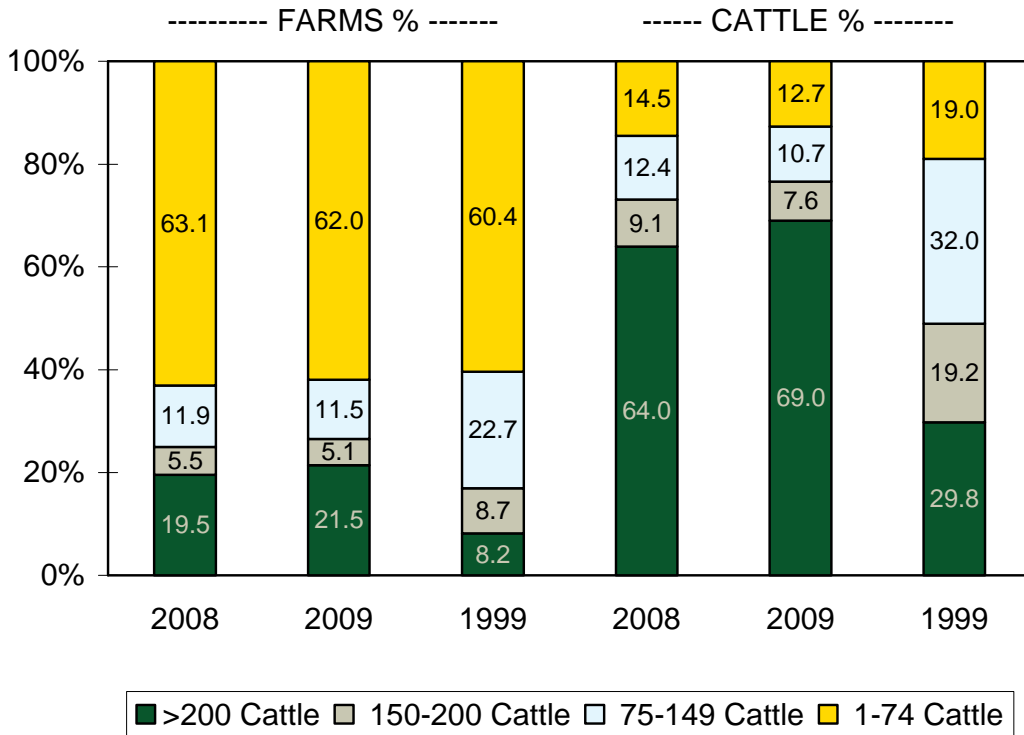

**Figure 5: HERD STRUCTURE - BY DISTRICTS - 1,000 HEAD**



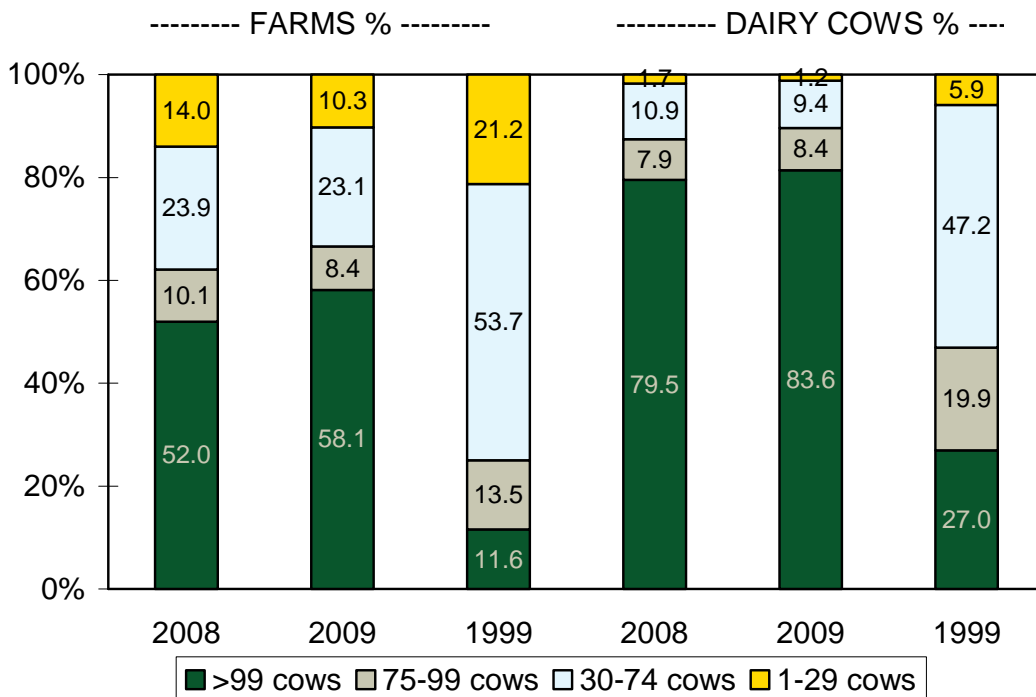
**FIGURE 6: HERD SIZE - CATTLE**

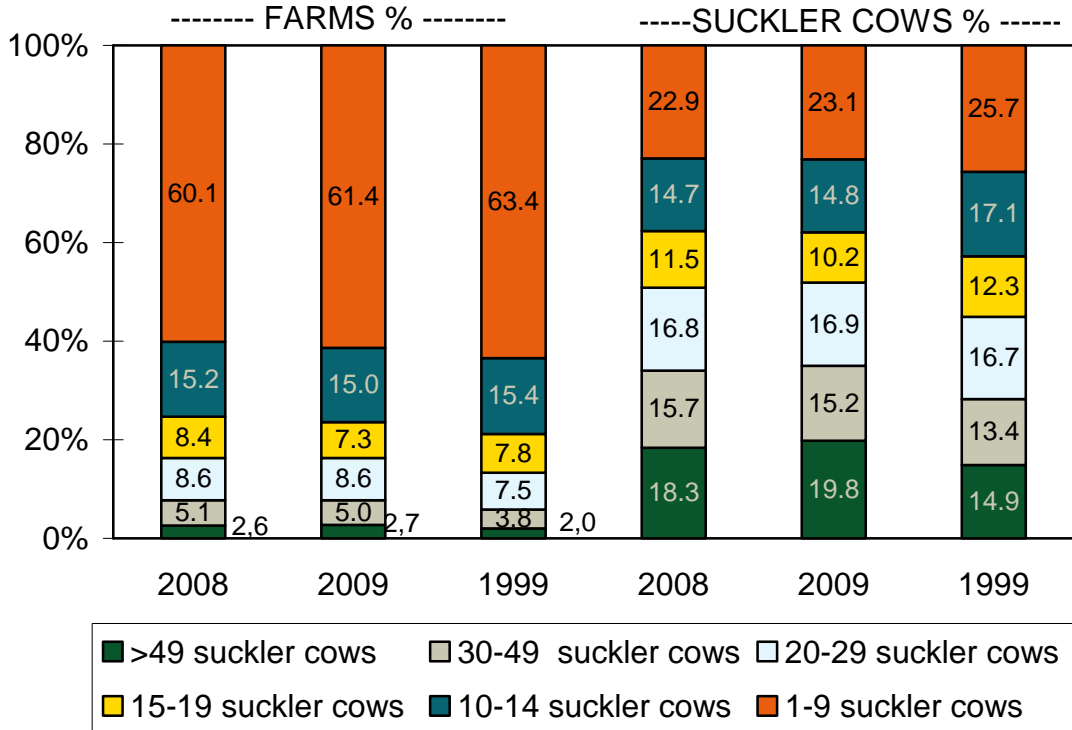
**B) DAIRY COWS**

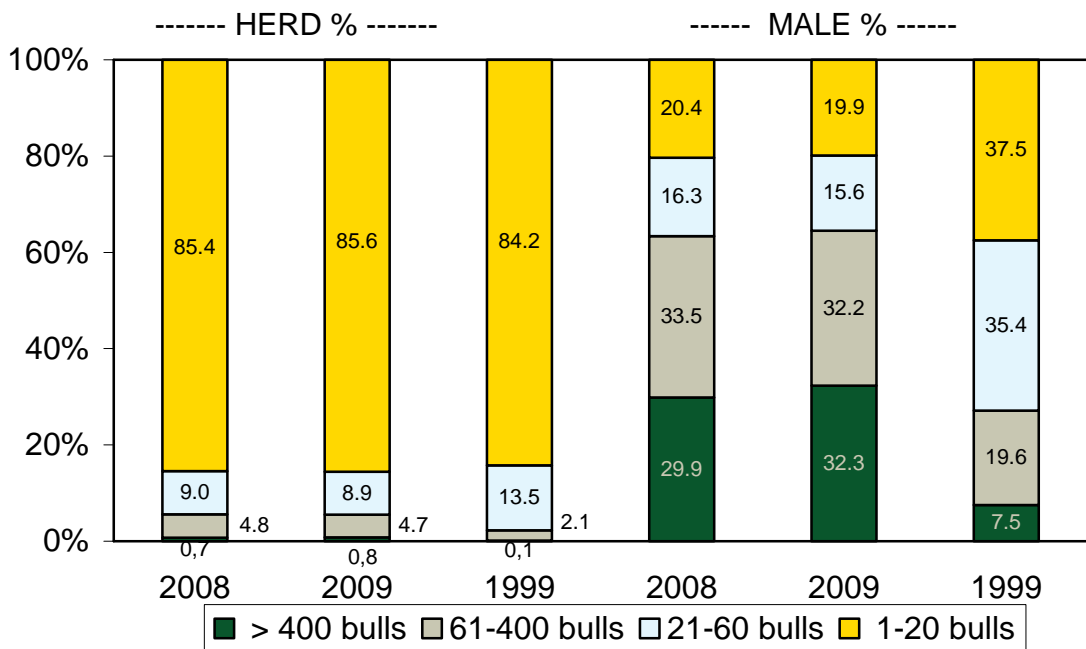
**FIGURE 6: HERD SIZE - CATTLE (CONTINUED)**

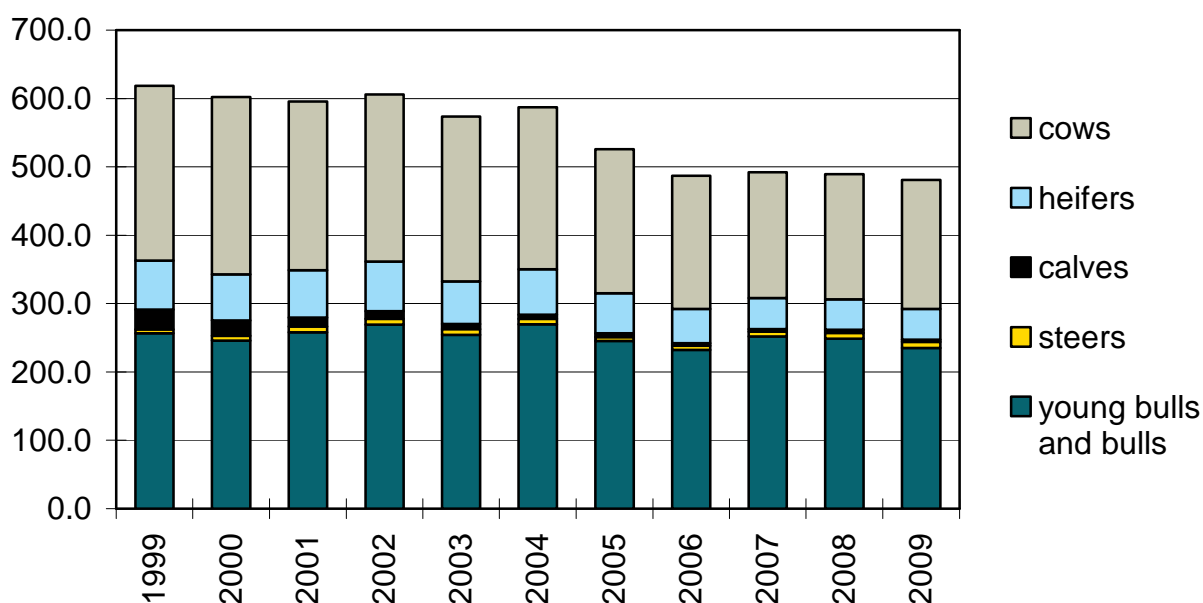

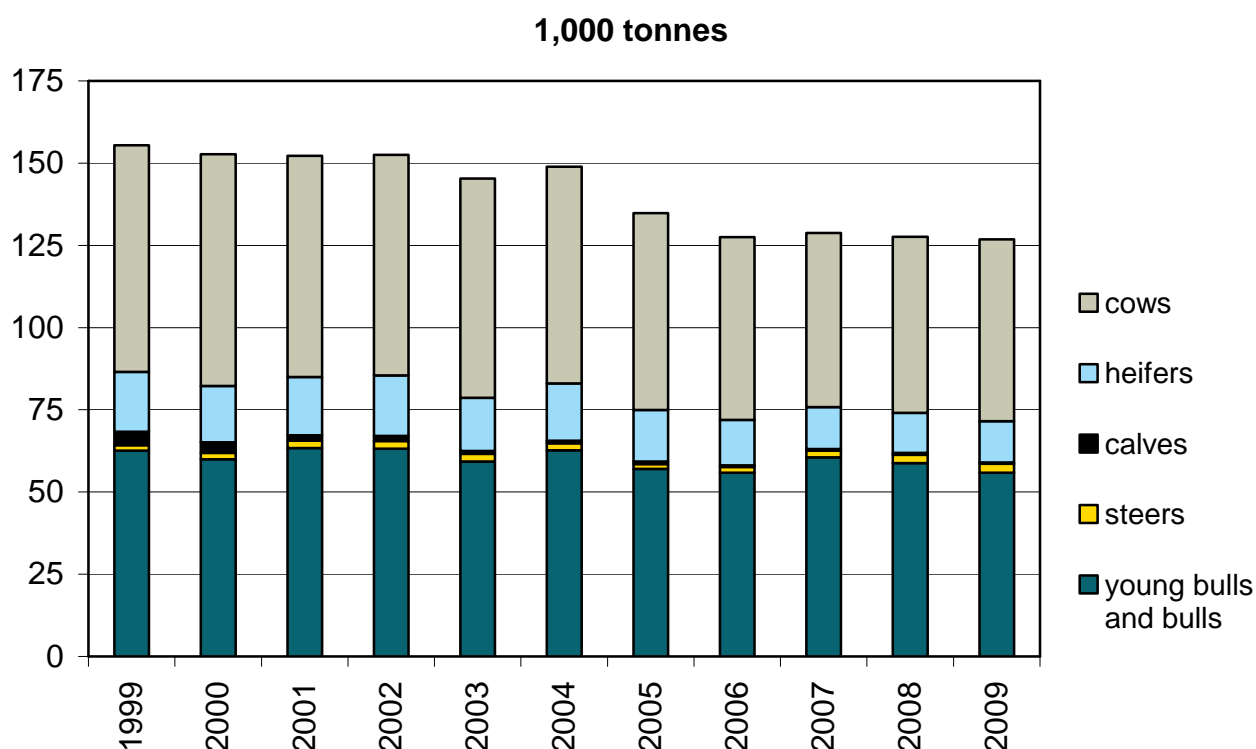

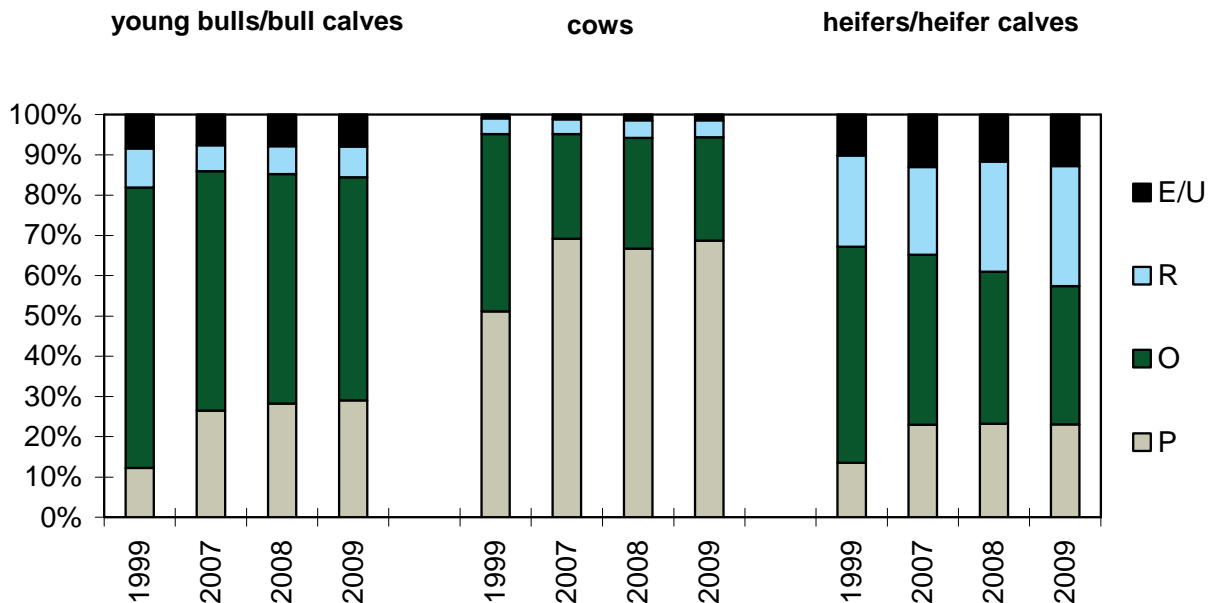

**Figure 10: CARCASSES CLASSIFIED AT EXPORT ABATTOIRS FOR CATTLE**



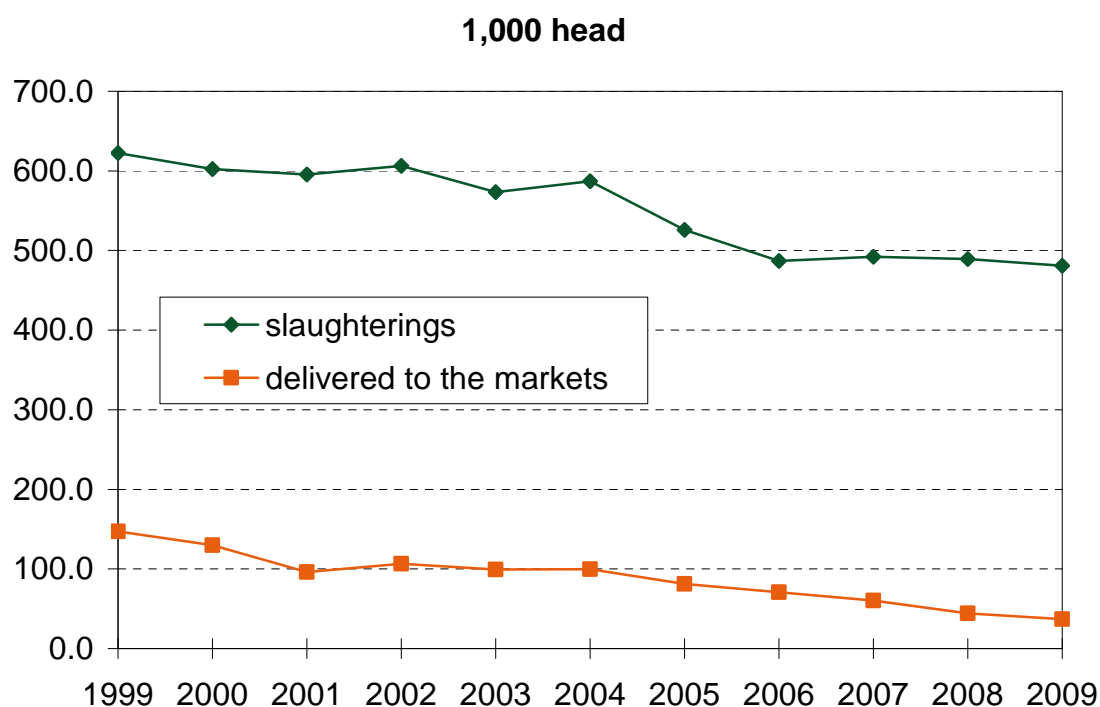

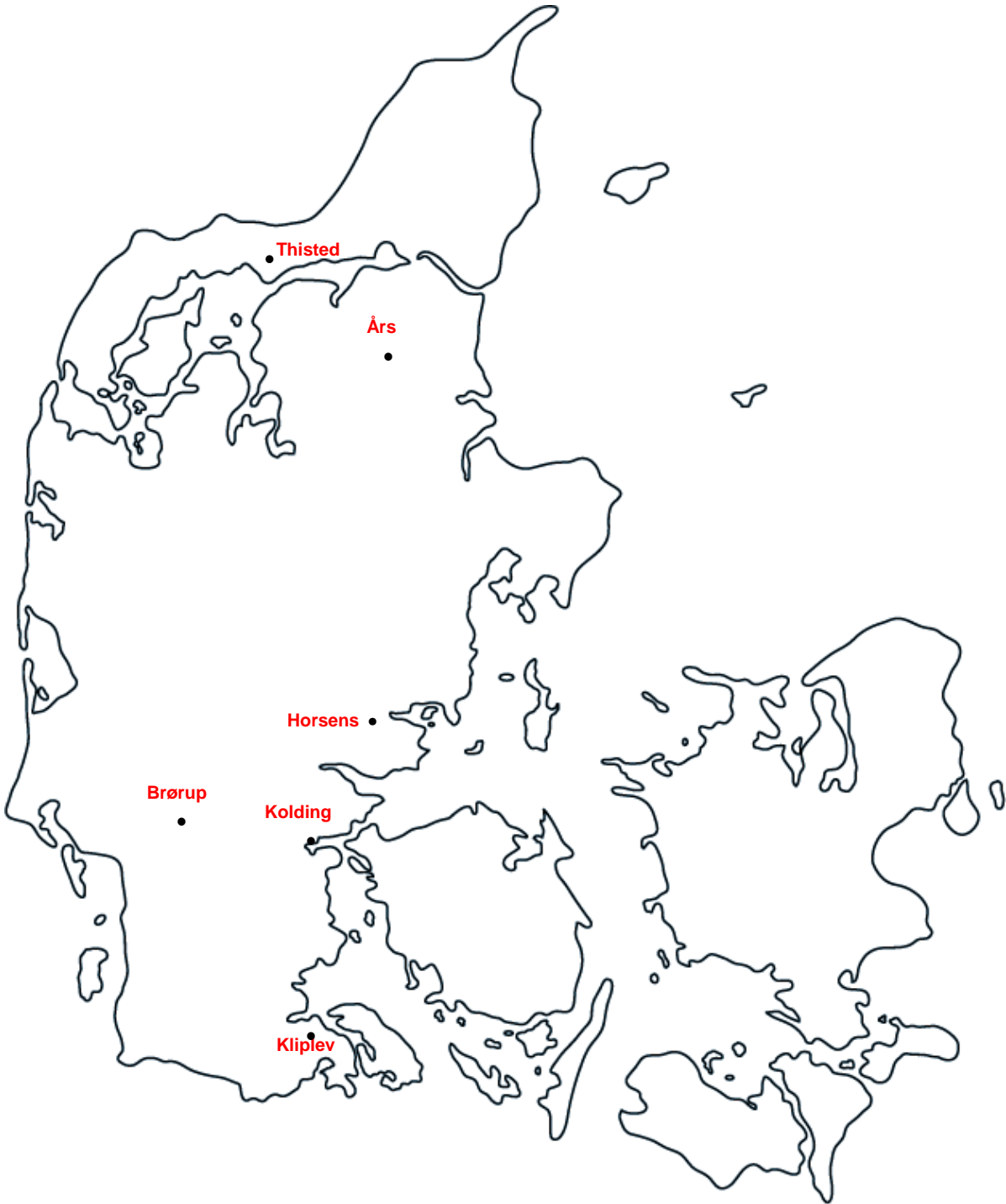

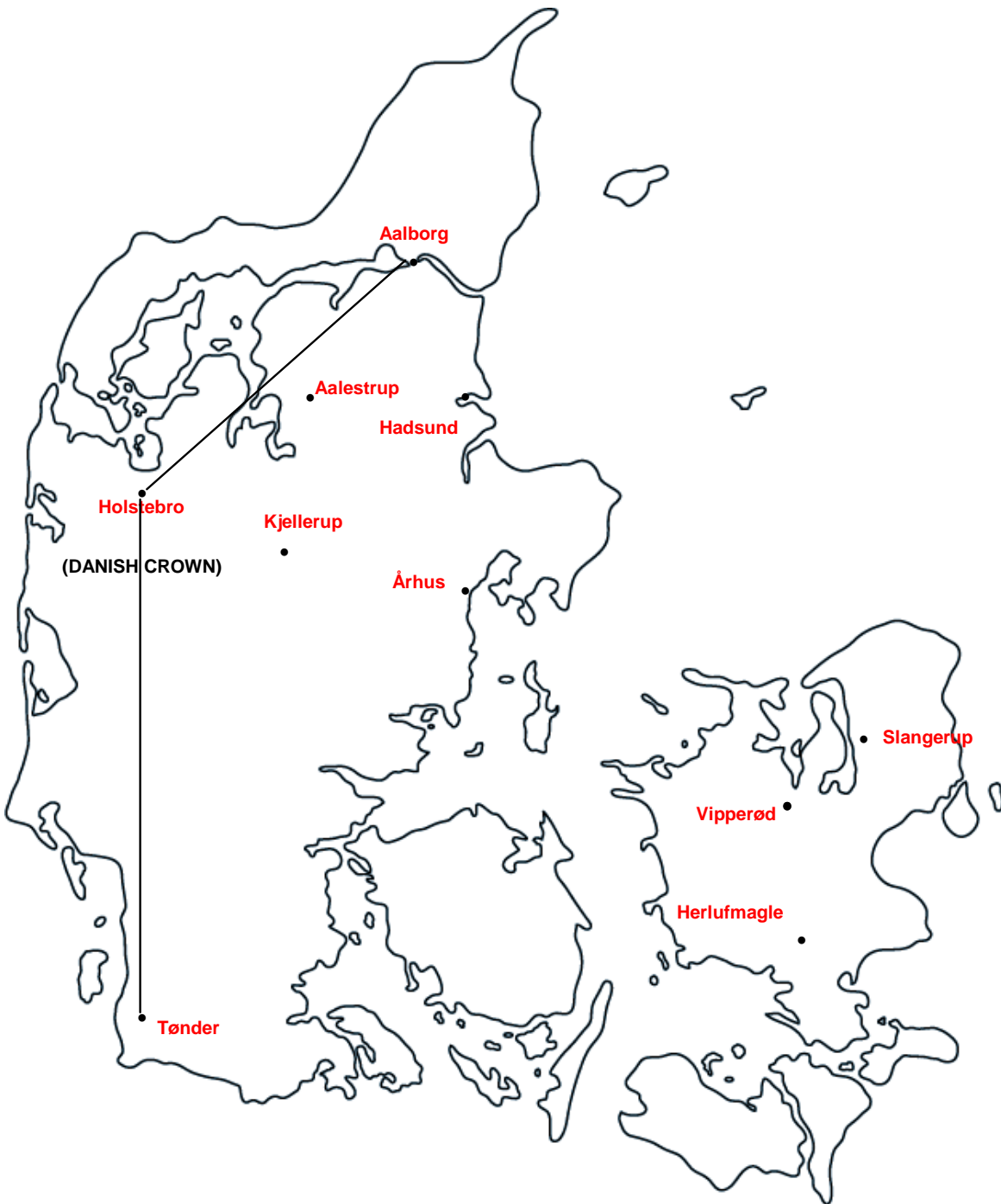

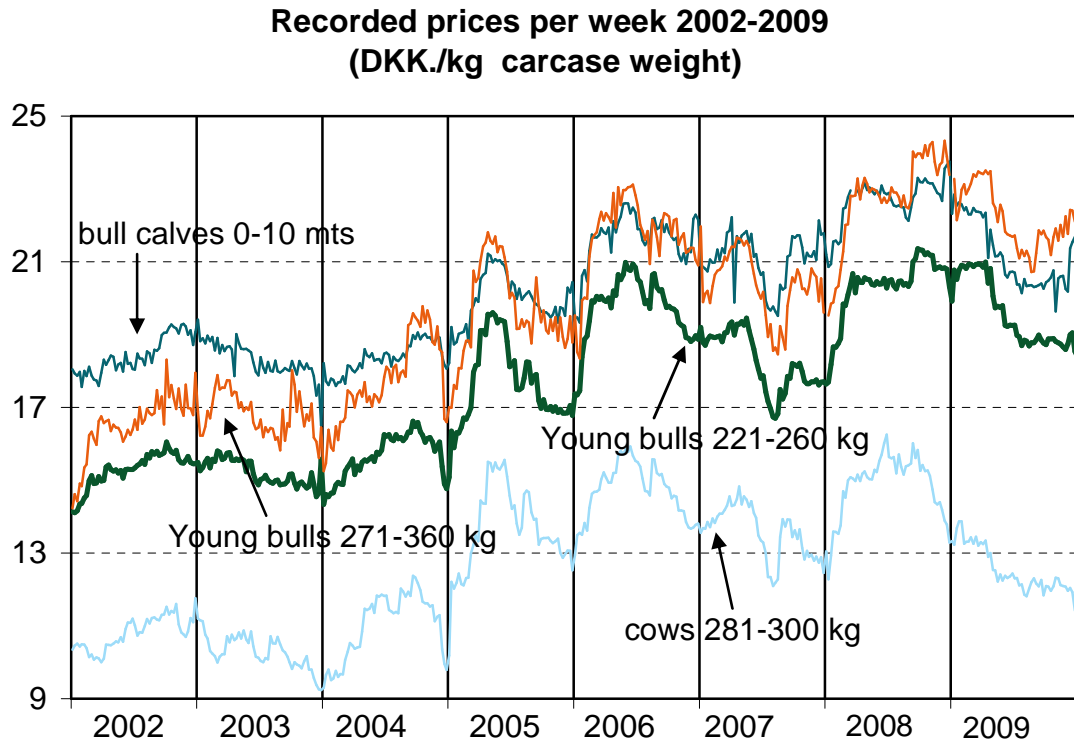

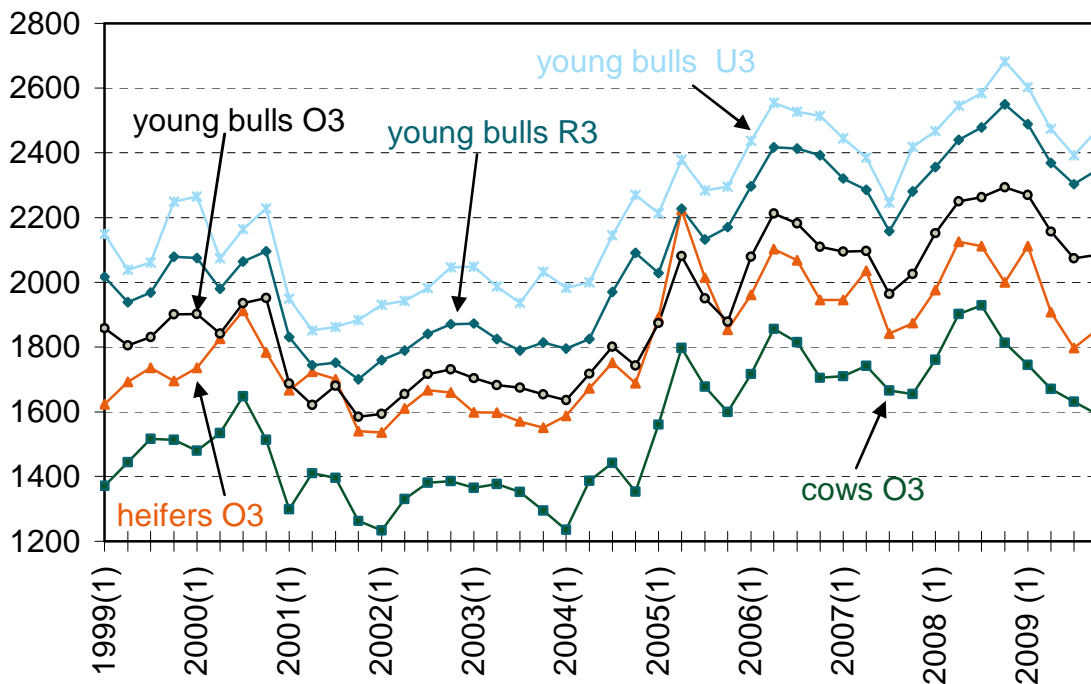

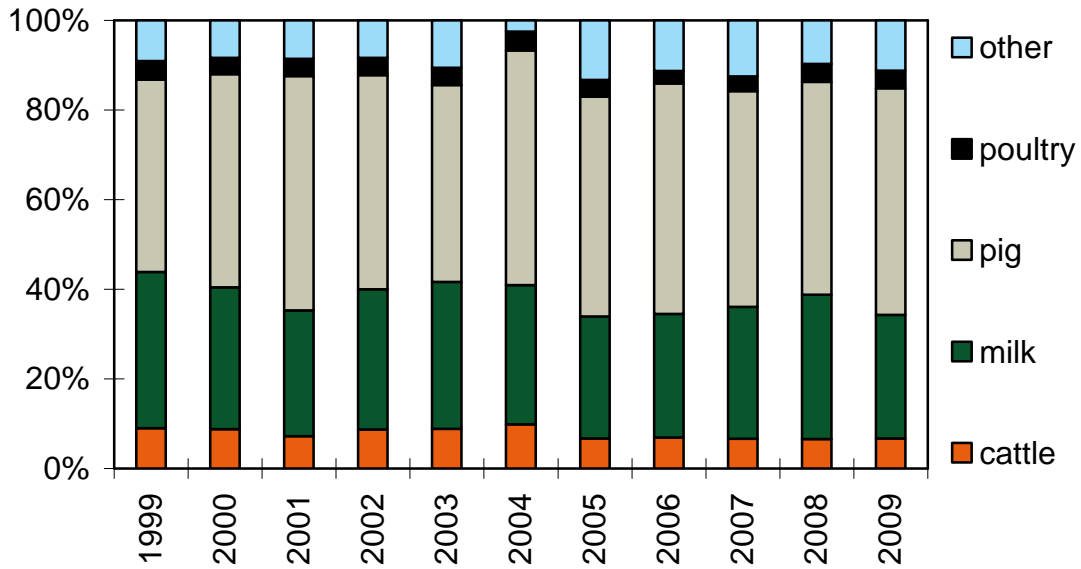

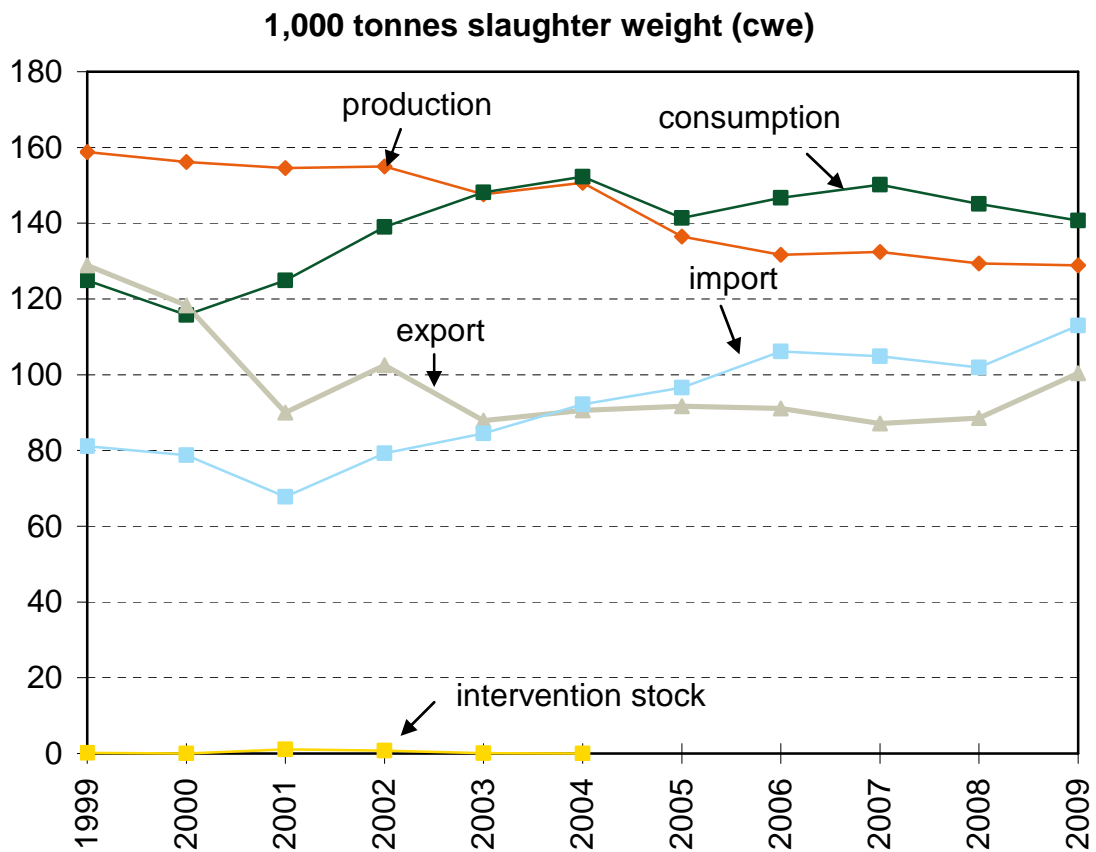

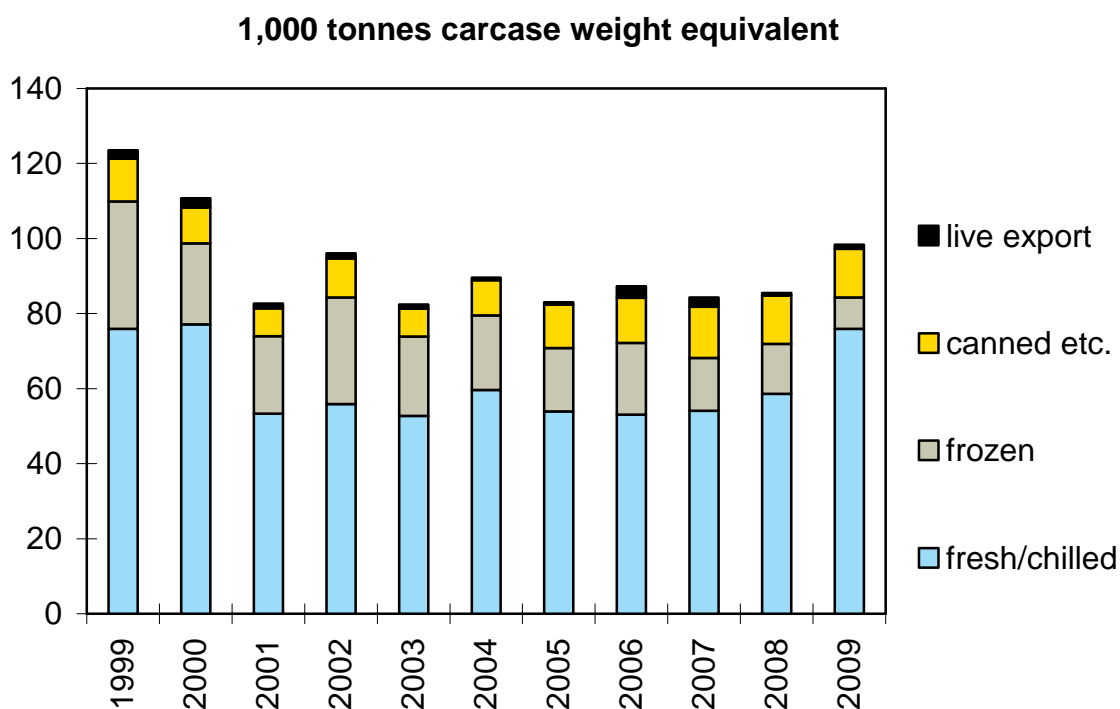

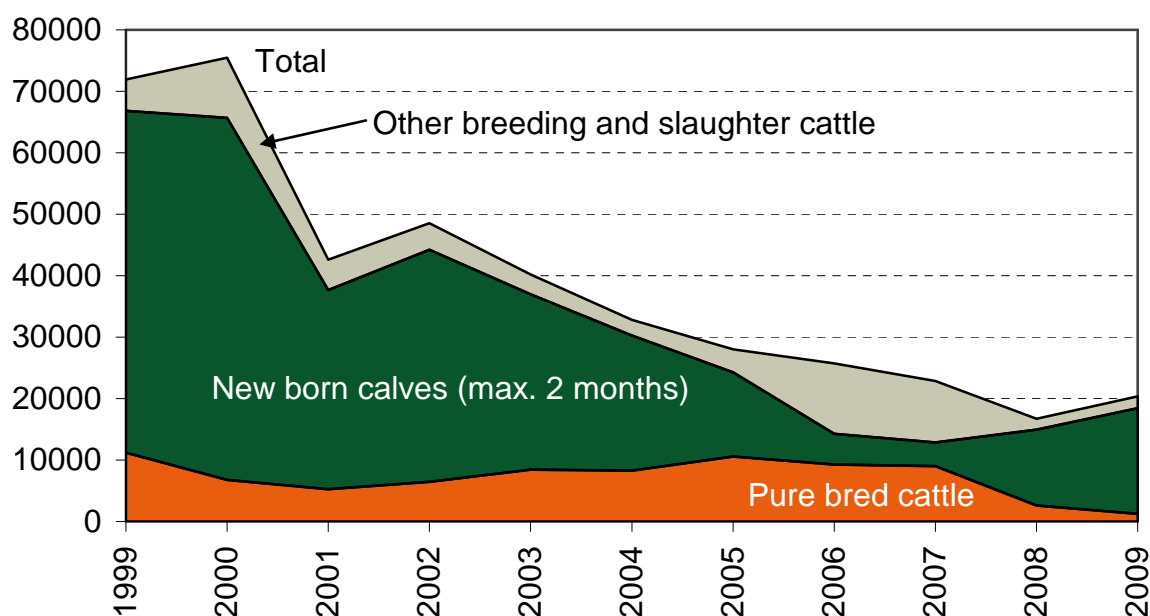

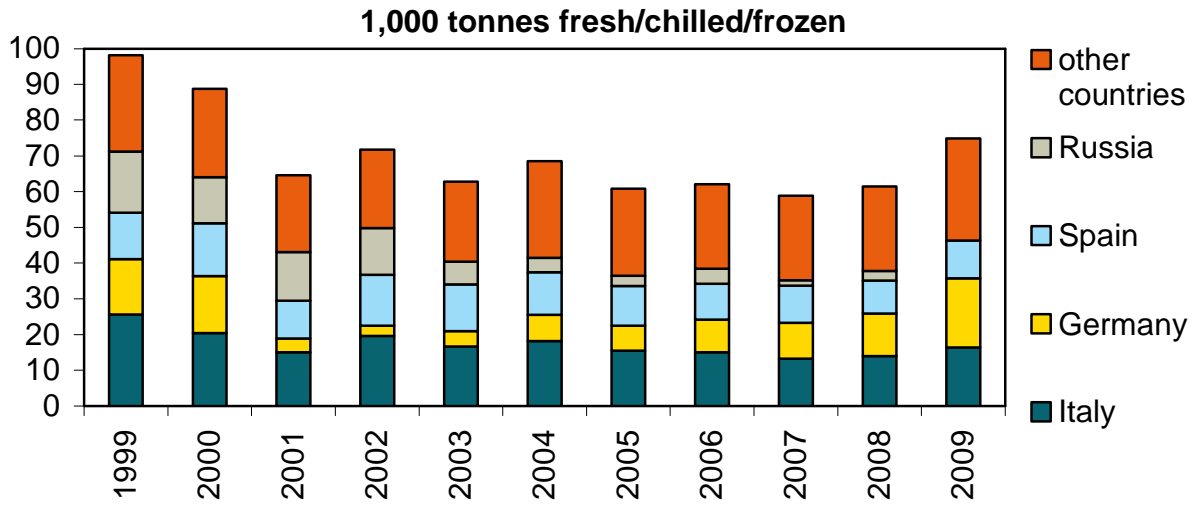

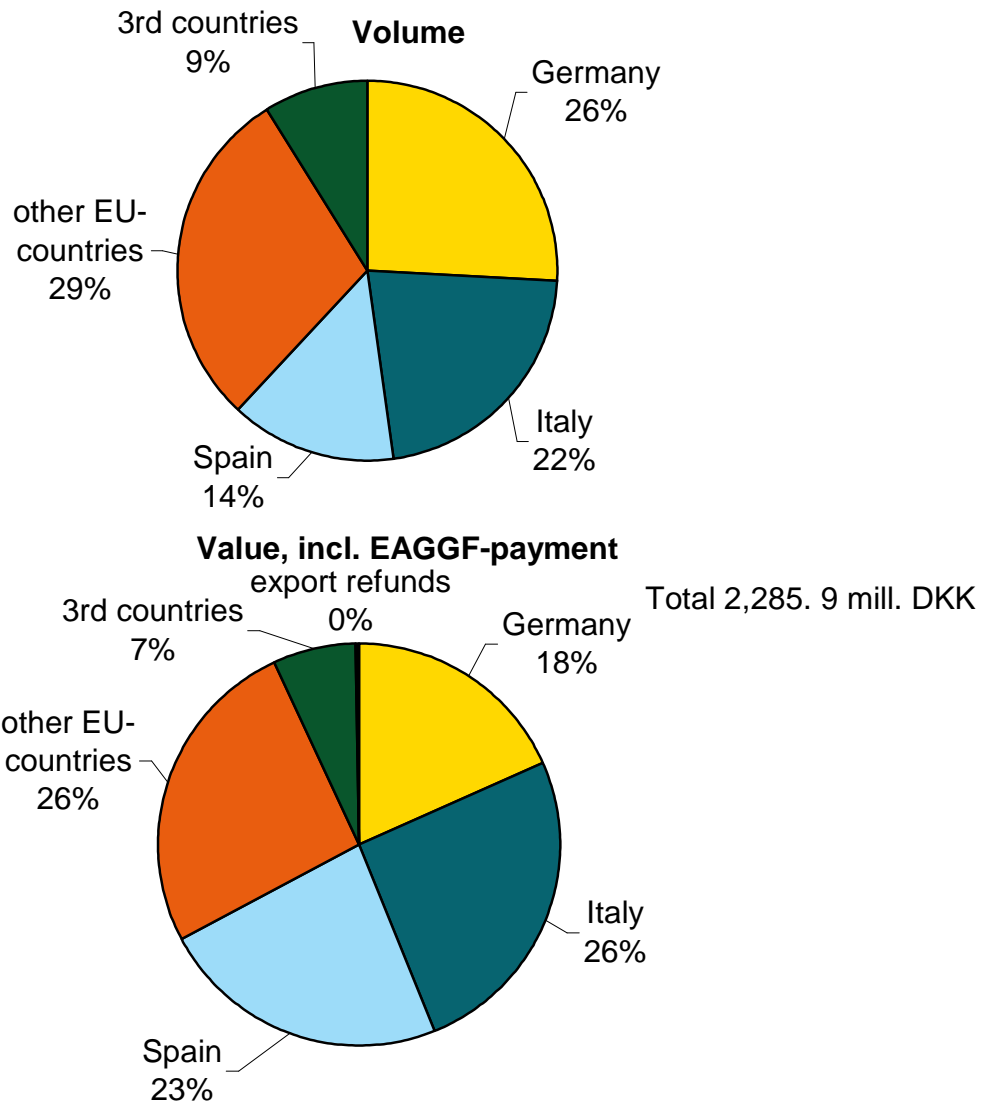

- percentage distribution on the major destinations



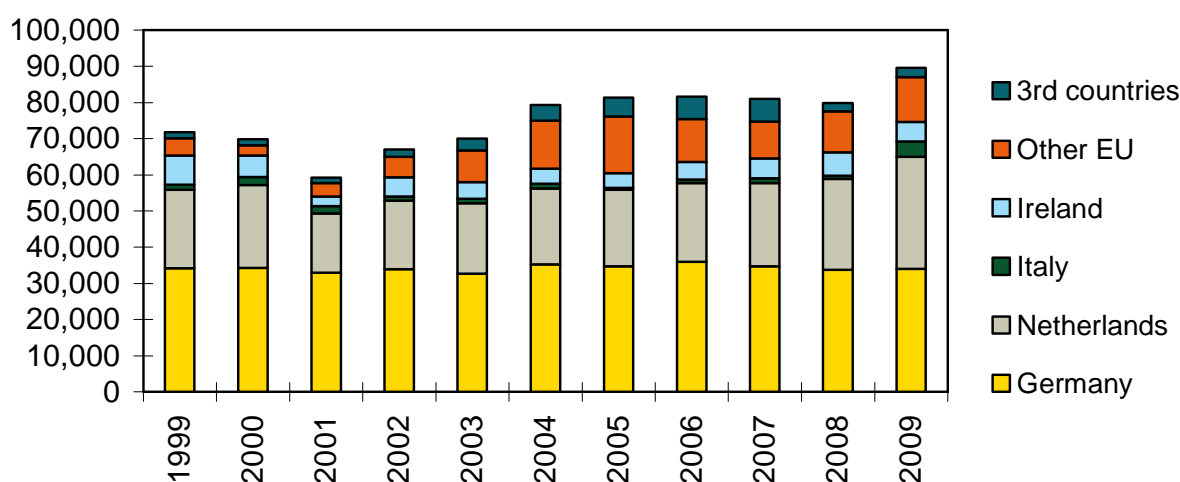

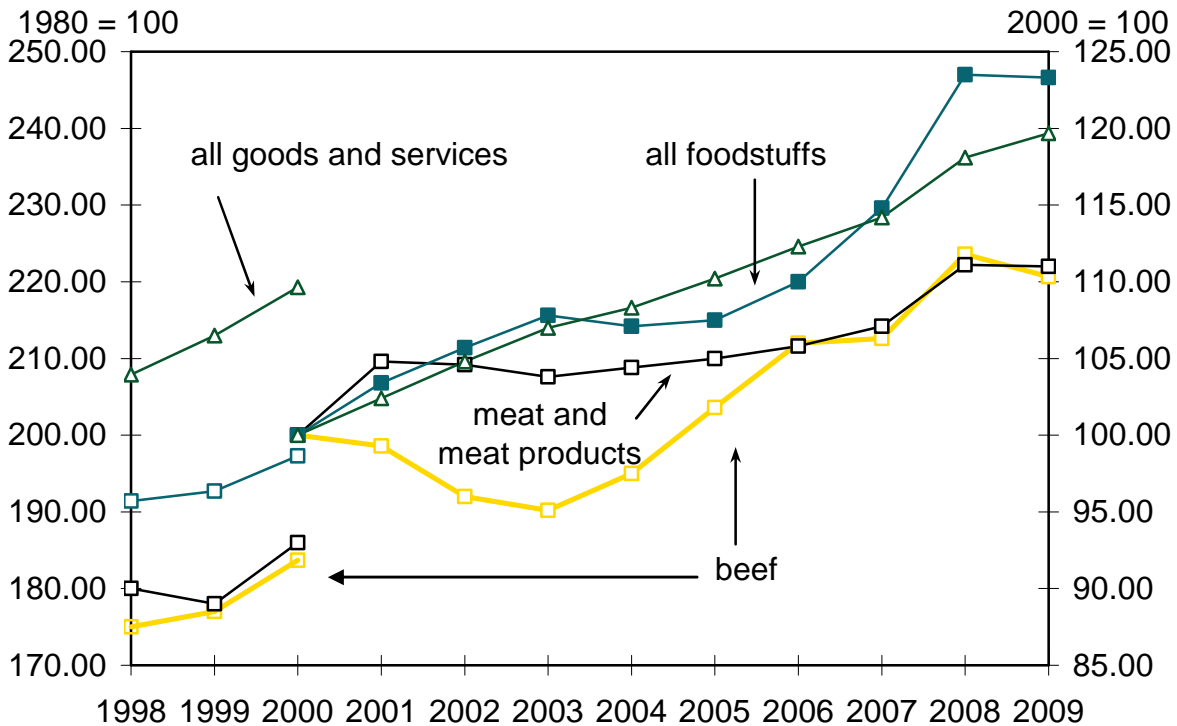
